Mr. Robert Scottaline, Mayor of the Village of Lake Grove and Attorney Joseph Prokop. They discussed the “positive things” and “negative things” about being an incorporated village. One of the positive things is that a Village can have stricter laws and would have more control regarding building and traffic. Some villages have their own police, highway department, garbage, etc. Usually an incorporated village is no more than 5 sq. miles, or you can use the boundaries of a municipal district. A petition is needed and sent to the 2 different town supervisors. There is then a joint hearing. The petition needs 20% of registered voters. All town roads become village roads, but state roads stay the same. All emergency service and water districts stay the same.
