Guest Speakers –

Jim Tampellini – No updated information on Marion Carll Farm. Still in litigation. Jim says the school district should move to dismiss case. School District has done nothing. Jim said he sent a petition to the school board to increase school board members from 5 to 7. Jim feels the budget is too big for 5 people to manage. He also stated that other school districts have 7 and 9 members. There are also issues with having the same 5 people year after year. He is urging us to vote for the proposition and any new incumbents.

They spoke about a new restaurant a 21,000 sq. foot structure being built in Mayfair Shopping Center. The impact on the community in that area, Verbena Dr. and the blocks in that area would be greatly affected by the traffic, smells, sewage issues, parking, security etc. The permits were issued 15 years ago. There is a public meeting on Wed. April 3th at 8:00 pm.

Wendy mentioned the Hartland Project. David Wolkoff, the developer is looking to develop 900 apartments which could be 13 stories high. 10% will be low income.
